Federal Reserve Bank & California African American Museum

This wonderful day in Los Angeles starts with a visit to the **Fed Gallery: Your Central Bank in Focus**, a permanent installation at the Los Angeles Branch that uses interactive technology and vivid graphics to highlight the Federal Reserve's role in the United States economy. Various displays focus on cash and check operations, bank supervision, and monetary policy. The gallery includes a pachinko-style game in which the participant rates the safety and soundness of a particular financial institution, a money wheel that asks visitors to identify counterfeit notes, and a currency display featuring historic and rare notes. We will stop at **Mercado La Paloma** for lunch on your own. Mercado La Paloma is located in the Figueroa Corridor of South Los Angeles a neighborhood that is full of creative and hardworking entrepreneurs, community spirit, artists, musicians and cultural traditions. Here you will find a variety of low cost food including burgers and sandwiches, fabulous Mexican fare, spectacular Thai dishes, and Ethiopian delights. There will be time to browse the shops of the Mercado before heading off to the **California African American Museum**. The highlight of our museum visit will be the exhibit *Politics, Race, and*

Propaganda: The Nazi Olympics, Berlin 1936. This exhibit features historic photographs and documents, riveting films, Olympics regalia and promotional materials, along with first-person accounts that tell the stories of athletes who were barred because of their ethnic heritage, those who boycotted the Games in protest, and the African Americans who competed and won a total of fourteen medals, refuting the Nazi myth of “Aryan” supremacy. **This exhibition was organized by United States Holocaust Memorial Museum.** To prepare you for this exhibit ONEgeneration will be showing the movie **Race** to all participants of this trip on January 24, 2017 at 9:30am. **This tour is limited to 25 participants.**

Though everyone will have the option of participating in a rich selection of engaging public talks and tours that are offered throughout the day, **a private guided tour will be offered at 1:30pm to the first 30 people to register for this trip.**

MEETING MR. WRIGHT

Come celebrate what would be Frank Lloyd Wright's 150th birthday as our local expert joins us for a comprehensive overview of Frank Lloyd Wright's California architecture. This modern architecture tour examines five of the architect's buildings including four concrete textile block houses of the 1920's in the Hollywood Hills, as well as a shopping center that Wright designed on Rodeo Drive in Beverly Hills in the 1950's. The tour delves into Wright's biography, his architectural philosophy, his connections to California, and his ideas on "organic architecture." Our day will include a visit to Hollyhock House, Frank Lloyd Wright's first Los Angeles project. Built between 1919 and 1921, it represents his earliest efforts to develop a regionally appropriate style of architecture for Southern California. Wright himself referred to it as California Romanza, using a musical term meaning "freedom to make one's own form". On our docent led tour of the house, we'll see warm wood features and 100 leaded glass windows which were designed by Wright for the house. We'll have free time for lunch at Hollywood & Highland with over 25 full-service and fast-casual restaurants to choose from.


