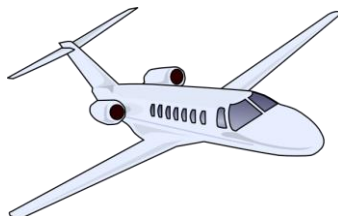

Southern Delight (FE) – March 2-8, 2019

7 Days & 6 Nights – 6 Breakfasts & 2 Dinners

Sightseeing highlights include cities of Atlanta (GA), Charleston (SC) and Savannah (GA). The day begins with a tour of Atlanta and a visit to the Georgia Aquarium, the nation's largest aquarium. Start Day 3 with a walking tour through Charleston's cobblestone streets including Drayton Hall, founded in 1738. Then we visit Charleston City Market and the Boone Hall Plantation, which is a "living history" and an active agricultural facility.
