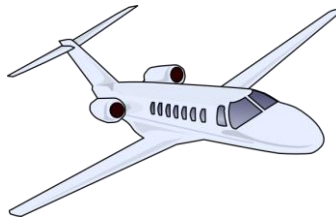

Islands of New England (C) August 2-9, 2019

8 Days & 7 Nights – 7 Breakfasts, 1 lunch & 3 Dinners

Highlights include Providence, Newport, Boston, Cranberry Bog, Plimoth Plantation, and Provincetown. Your tour opens in Providence, Rhode Island as you discover the beauty that lies along the shores of New England and return to America's Gilded Age as you traverse breathtaking Ocean Drive en route to Bellevue Avenue towards Newport. The following day we visit the historical city of Boston, visiting Beacon Hill, the Old South Meeting House, and Faneuil Hall Marketplace (Opened 1742).
